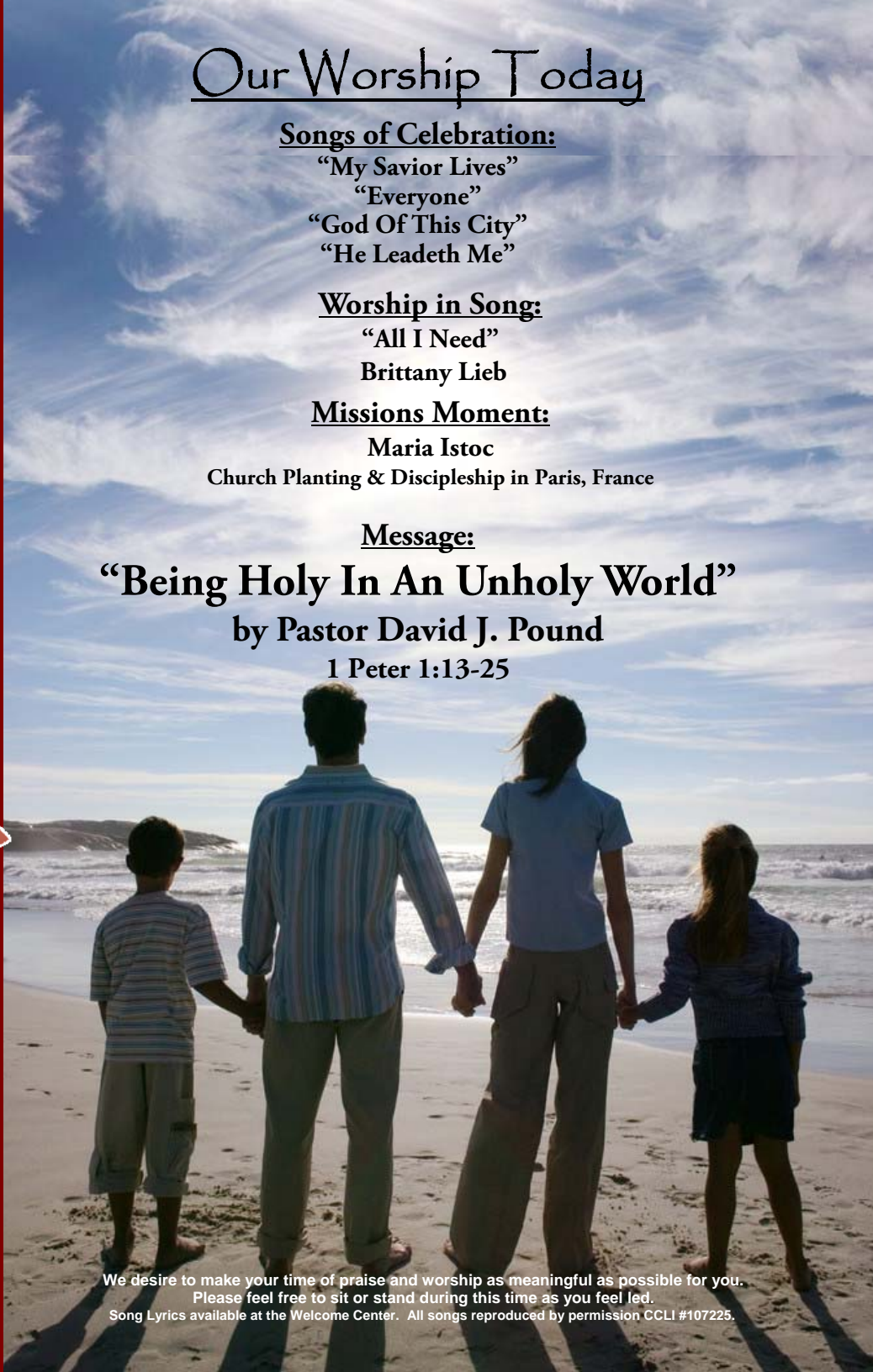

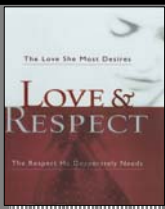

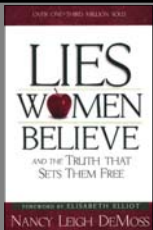
Sunday School Class Option

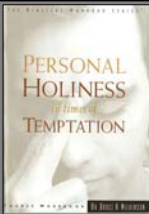
Sunday School Class Option

Bring your child to the gym after service today to recite all three verses for the quarter and receive their ribbon.

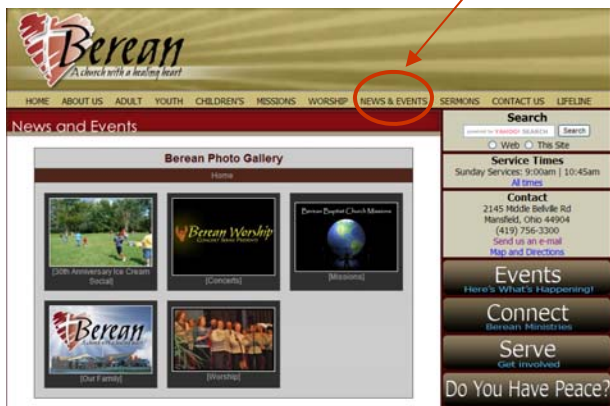
LAST DAY TO PRE-REGISTER

2009-2010 CLASSES

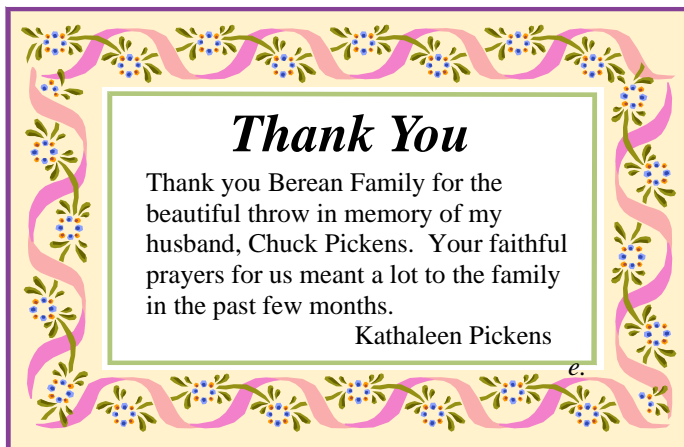
All children (3 years old – 5th grade) move into their new classrooms next Sunday, Sept. 6th. Look for signs on the doors. Some elementary classrooms have moved.

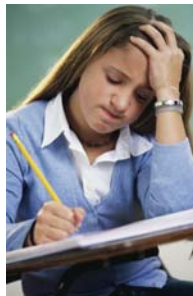
